## Kindness Giving Cards

- **Healing Through Serving:** Use the **Kindness Giving Cards** to brighten someone's day. Think beyond yourself while you're helping others.
- **Kindness Confetti: Spread Kindness** like confetti by attaching cards to places around your school or on desks of co-workers in your office space.
- **Appreciate Kindness:** Leave **Kindness Giving Cards** in hospitals or doctors' offices to thank the staff for their service to others.

## Kindness Promise Cards

- **Play a Kinder Together Game:** With your family or friends, sit in a circle and write down on a **Kindness Promise Card** how you can do an **Act of Kindness** for the person to your right.
- **A Time of Kindness:** At the beginning of a period (day, week, etc.) make a resolution to write down one major **Kindness Promise** goal to accomplish during that time.
- **Community Outreach:** Think of how you would like to serve in your community. Fill in a **Kindness Promise Card** with the first action you will take to fulfill your mission.

## Kindness Receiving Cards

- Use **Kindness Receiving Cards** to talk about the **Kindness** you've experienced in your day.
- Create a collage in your classroom or workplace so that everyone can discuss the **Kindness** they have received.
- **Kindness Appreciation Week:** Set up an appreciation display where students can show how they appreciate teachers, principals, custodians, secretaries, and staff.

## Share It Forward Cards

- **Start a Share It Forward Club:** Encourage others to join and become **Kindness Ambassadors**. Create and share ideas about how to **Share Kindness Forward** in your community. Broadcast your ideas on social media, or other communication channels.
- Spark a **Share Kindness Forward Vision:** Use the **Share It Forward Cards** in your organization or business to discuss and list multiple ways to enlist other business to join you to promote and act on your **Share Kindness Forward Vision**.
- **Kindness Certificates.** Show your support for the **Kindness Movement** by posting a **Kindness Certificate** in your store or office window, classroom, door, wall, website, or social media channel. Generate recognition for the **Kindness** others create in your community with **Kindness Certificates**. There are other **Kindness Certificates** (Butterfly, Hero, Leader, Partner, Pathfinder, Sponsor) and we/you can make more.
